

Answering The Macedonian Call

Acts 16:9-10 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. (10) And after he had seen the vision, immediately we endeavoured to go into Macedonia, assuredly gathering that the Lord had called us for to preach the gospel unto them.

Acts 16:25-28 And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them. (26) And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed. (27) And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled. (28) But Paul cried with a loud voice, saying, Do thyself no harm: for we are all here.

Acts 8:5-8 Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and preached Christ unto them. (6) And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. (7) For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed. (8) And there was great joy in that city.

Acts 8:26-29 And the angel of the Lord spake unto Philip, saying, Arise, and go toward the south unto the way that goeth down from Jerusalem unto Gaza, which is desert. (27) And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to worship, (28) Was returning, and sitting in his chariot read Esaias the prophet. (29) Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.



Reporting Guidance

- 1. Pastors report monthly (regardless of ministerial rank: Bishop, Evangelist, Deacon, etc.) both to the Regional Overseer and to General Headquarters.

 See bottom of Minister's report book.
- 2. <u>Local Treasurers</u> report <u>monthly</u> both to Regional Treasurer and to General Headquarters. See Treasurer's report book.

Otherwise (not a pastor):

- 3. <u>Bishops</u>, <u>Evangelists</u>, and <u>Certified Teachers</u> report <u>monthly</u> both to Regional Overseer and to General Head-quarters. See <u>top</u> of Minister's report book.
- 4. <u>Lay Ministers, Lay Teachers, and non-preaching Deacons</u> report <u>quarterly</u> both to local church quarterly conference and to Regional Overseer.

 See <u>top</u> of Minister's report book.
- 5. <u>Retired</u> ministers report <u>annually</u> to both the Regional Overseer and to General Headquarters. See top of Minister's report book.
